Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

Equine Canada is committed to:

- ◆ Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- ◆ Requiring that horses to be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subject to mistreatment;
- ◆ Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- ◆ Providing for continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard procedure;
- ◆ Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- ◆ Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- ◆ Requiring owners, trainers, and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within the industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- ◆ Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

**The Atlantic Canada Arabian Horse Show Competitions are sanctioned by Class 7 Competition member of Equine Canada and is governed by the rules of the Federation. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of Equine Canada and will be judged in accordance with the Equine Canada Rule Book.**

**Officers, delegates, members, volunteers of the Atlantic Canada Arabian Horse Association and employees of the Princess Louise Park Show Centre of Sussex, NB, accept no responsibility for the loss or damage to any person(s) or animal(s) while exhibiting at these shows.**

---

**AHA Resolution 13-85:** Cruelty or abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, paddock area, schooling area, or show ring or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.

**Arrival, Unloading & Parking:** Earliest arrival date is Friday July 3, 2009. Please do not block access with vehicles when loading and unloading. Electricity and water hookup are available for a fee of \$50. All improperly parked vehicles or trailers may be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

**Article A905 Headgear: Approved Headgear Compulsory Rule for ALL JUNIORS:** (January 1, 2003 Equine Canada) For primary, Provincial and National Equine Canada sanctioned competitions: Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear meets the ASTM standards and displays the SEI seal. At present, if the junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. Western hats, derbies); those rules supersede the new rule. However, almost all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty. Exhibitors will not be penalized regardless of what they choose to wear. Junior exhibitors must dismount outside of the ingate prior to changing headgear. Junior exhibitor's helmets will be inspected by the Steward. *If a helmet does not meet standards, the junior exhibitor will not be permitted to school on the competition grounds or compete at this event.*

**ARTICLE A1001: EQUINE MEDICATIONS CONTROL:** "Any horse entered in any class at this competition is subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees, may while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chair of the Provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chair's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing." EC Article A602.5.

**CALL FOR CLASSES:** Classes will be called promptly. First call when horses' two (2) classes ahead enter the ring. Second call when preceding class enters the ring. Third call while ribbons are being awarded in preceding class. To prevent delays, we must adhere to the two (2) minute gate call limit, after which the gate will be closed. We appreciate your cooperation and caution exhibitors against entering consecutive classes unless proper planning will allow for clothing and tack changes within the **two (2) minute limit**. **Class holds will be allowed for exhibitors with back to back classes only -please advise your Steward and the gate person.** Responsibility for entering classes on time rests solely with the exhibitor.

**COMPETITORS:** Competitors, parents, coaches, or assigns on behalf of any competitor may not approach the judge. The show steward may be used as a liaison.

**COMPETITION NUMBERS:** Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and/or exercise areas, as well in the competition ring (A814).

**DISCIPLINE:** Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials of the Shows on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the shows will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The ACAHA reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, trainer, groom rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the shows from the show without being liable for compensation of damages. Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, steward or show veterinarian, in this show ring or anywhere on the show grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the ACAHA. Such action(s) could include, but are not limited to excessive use of whip, spurs or sticks.

**DISQUALIFICATION:** Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or cause to be made any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judge in the performance of his/her duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In any case of any animal being disqualified the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class of the disqualified animal.

**ENTRY FORMS:** Entry forms at these recognized shows (AHA # **09189781 & 09189782**) shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, the owner, lessee, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and the horse, shall be subject to the Constitution and the rules of the Equine Canada.

- ◆ All entries must be submitted on the Official ACAHS Entry Form and be accompanied by the required fees as indicated. No telephone entries are permitted.
- ◆ Entry forms may be returned if incomplete or incorrect or received without full payment, at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- ◆ Cheques returned for any reason by the issuing bank will be subject to an automatic charge by the ACAHA of \$25.00 unless otherwise indicated. Failure to fulfill indebtedness will result in this file being forwarded to AHA and Equine Canada for further action.
- ◆ Substitution of horses will **NOT** be allowed after the June 20, 2009 closing date of entries.
- ◆ All entry fees are payable in Canadian Funds by money order, bank draft, cheque or cash. No U.S. cheques will be accepted with "Canadian Funds" written on them. Total fees must accompany each entry. Late entries are acceptable at the fees of \$20 a horse.
- ◆ Person Responsible: (Article A1011) This person shall be deemed the trainers of the horse, owner, rider, driver, agent and/or coach. For junior competitors, a parent or guardian must sign the entry form if there is no other person responsible. With the exception of the parent or guardian, the person responsible who signs an entry form must hold an EC individual or group license. The entry form must be signed by the person responsible or parent/guardian of a competitor if a junior.
- ◆ All horses belonging to one owner must be entered on one entry form. If additional entry forms are required photocopies of this form are acceptable.
- ◆ The complete address of the registered owner must appear in the space provided on the entry form. Farm names will be used **ONLY** if the owner appearing on the horse(s) registration papers or if the stable or farm name has been registered with the EC/USAE.
- ◆ All creditable refunds will be processed no later than thirty (30) days of the closing of the shows and payable to the party whose name appears on the horses' registration papers.
- ◆ Show Management reserves the right to decline any entry and return any entry fees without being liable to compensation subject to the Equine Canada rule A805.
- ◆ It has been made mandatory by AHA that the following information be required with all entry forms for each owner.
  1. AHA owner membership number/copy of card;
  2. Horse's registered name/correct registration number/copy of registration papers;
  3. Owner's full name, complete address, postal code;
  4. All horses must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor or under legal lease (copy of which must be provided). Horses purchased on time are permitted to be shown and entered in any class (except Amateur-owner classes) under the Purchaser's name providing a written contract of sale can be produced to the Show Secretary (as required by EC/USAE Leased horses are excluded from Amateur Owner classes (Art.B103.1)).
  5. Amateur owner number and cards must be present for all Amateur Owner to Ride/Drive/ Handle classes. Combined ownership is allowed in Amateur Owner classes only when these owners are members of the same immediate family.
  6. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Equine Canada Rule Book including amendments and/or the rules of the Arabian Horse Association and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. These shows will run in accordance with the Code of Ethics of the AHA.

**PRESENTATION OF THE SIGNED ENTRY FORM SHALL BE DEEMED AS ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES, AND ALL RULES OF EQUINE CANADA AND AHA.**

**LATE FEES:** A one time late fee of \$20.00/horse will be applied to *any entry postmarked after midnight of June 20, 2009* the closing date for entries.

**NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST:** Equine Canada (A809) strongly recommends that all horse owners have their horses tested regularly for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) with a Coggins Test. The ACAHA also recommends that your horse(s) be kept up to date with inoculations.

**Paddock Area Conduct:** There will be no conduct in the paddock area or in-gate runway area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to the horses or handlers. There will be no whips (except in the show ring, whips properly carried by the handler) allowed in the paddock area. Bag whips, noise makers, rattlers, chains, buckets and cans with rocks, or other equipment, devices or objects which might disturb a horse or exhibitor or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the paddock or in-gate runway area are **PROHIBITED**.

**PRACTICE HOURS:** The indoor show ring will be open the day prior to the commencement of the shows, and will **close at 10:00pm that night**. The indoor show ring will remain open for approximately one (1) hour for exhibitors to practice immediately following Saturday evening classes. Exhibitors under saddle are urged to use the outside ring. Warm up is allowed in the outdoor ring for horses' no more than one class after the class being judged.

**PERPETUAL TROPHIES:** A perpetual trophy (\*as indicated on the class list for certain classes) will be awarded based on the overall scores for the two shows. The **scoring system is on page 9** of the prize list. A tie breaker judge will be randomly picked before the start

of the show. In the event that two exhibitors have the same score for a particular class with a perpetual trophy, the exhibitor with the highest score from the tie breaker judge will receive the perpetual trophy for the class.

**PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:** Payment for professional service or consultation performed by the show Veterinarian, Farrier or Photographer will be the responsibility of the exhibitor only. **(ACAHA will not be held responsible for these services).**

**RABIES INOCULATION:** The Show Committee strongly suggests your horses be inoculated for rabies and other equine diseases if attending the show.

**REFUNDS/VET SCRATCHES:** Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit all office and class entry fees. However, if a suitable Veterinarian's Certificate on official letterhead attesting to illness or injury is received by the Show Secretary seven days following the closing of the shows, 75% of all class entry fees will be refunded, and drug fees and stall fees will be reimbursed. Office fees and 9-90 fees are not refundable. In the case where a horse has been entered and not shown, all fees will be forfeited.

**SHOW ACCOUNTS:** An open account may be started at the shows for post entries only if a signed, blank cheque payable to ACAHA is left on file at the Show Office. If a posted class is charged to an exhibitor's show account, and is later scratched, the exhibitor is still responsible for payment of that class. Even exchanges for post and scratches will be allowed, provided they are done at the same time and for the same owner or payee.

**SHOW COMMITTEE:** The Committee reserves the right to retain additional officials in the event that it becomes necessary. Show Management has the right to change and modify the schedule of events as necessary to accommodate the entries received. When the number of entries will cause overcrowding in the show arena the class will be split upon the decision of the Show Management, and such splits will be announced. Show Management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing Equine Canada and AHA rules. Special emphasis will be placed on the rules pertaining to the retention of natural action and carriage; use of banned artificial appliance will be cause for immediate removal from the shows with all winnings forfeited. **NO ABUSE TO HORSES WILL BE TOLERATED.**

**SHOWING OUT OF TRAILER:** Exhibitors will be allowed to show from horse trailers and vans. At this show, no horse will be allowed to remain in a van or trailer overnight on showground's. Please note: there is a ground fee of \$15/day.

**SHOWRING ADMISSION:** No persons will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, judges, assistants, ringmasters and photographer. Attendants will be allowed only after being called by the judge or ringmaster.

**Please Note:** If you use a vacant straight stall you will be charged \$25.00. A grounds fee of \$15/day will be charged if you show off your trailer. Also, you will be CHARGED FOR A TACK STALL IF YOU USE ANY EXTRA SPACE FOR DISPLAYS. Bedding prices will be determined at a later date. However, exhibitors feel free to bring your own shavings or sawdust only if you wish.

**\*Fees apply to those exhibitors who are not a current member of the above organizations. Please be aware that you will have to purchase two memberships (with the exception of NBEA) as we are hosting two shows!**

Exhibitors are free to bring their own bedding from home if they wish - provided it is either shavings or sawdust. Straw, peat moss or other forms of bedding will not be permitted.

## Fee Descriptions

**AHA COMMISSIONERS FEE (RESOLUTION 9-90):** \$6.00 per horse (this fee must be paid on Sat & Sun entry form: \$12 in total).

**CAMPER & TRAILER FEES:** Camping is allowed in the designated areas for a \$50.00 fee for the duration of the shows. Electric and water hookup is available. You must at no time release Grey or sewer water on the ground or into storm drains.

**DRUG FEE:** Equine drugs and medications fee is \$5.00 per horse (this fee must be paid on Sat & Sun entry form: \$10 in total).

### NON-MEMBER FEES:

**Please be aware that you will have to purchase two memberships (with the exception of NBEA) as we are hosting two shows!**

- **AHA SINGLE EVENT FEE:** Every exhibitor must have a Competition Level membership in AHA or shall be a Single Event Member. AHA Competition Level Memberships are also required for owners and trainers. This membership shall only have

exhibiting privileges for the duration of the event where the membership is purchased. Single Event Membership does not include personal excess liability insurance coverage, and is \$40.00 per person, payable in Canadian Funds by Money Order or Bank Draft.

- **EQUINE CANADA TEMPORARY MEMBERSHIP:** All exhibitors, owners and handlers must be a member of Equine Canada. Either a temporary (*valid for one show only*), non-member EC membership must be purchased at \$30.00 per person, or an EC Associate Membership at \$40.00 per person. To obtain an Equine Canada membership, exhibitors must be a member of their Provincial Sport Office (PSO) (e.g. NB Equestrian Association, NS Equestrian Federation).
- **NBEA MEMBERSHIP:** All exhibitors must hold a current membership with a PSO (e.g. NBEA, NSEA) for liability insurance. Those exhibitors not possessing a current membership to a PSO, must purchase an NBEA membership (35.00 per person). Memberships may be purchased at the Show Office. Temporary NBEA memberships are no longer available.

**OFFICE FEE:** \$30.00 per horse. This fee includes office processing of entry forms, exhibitor's number, one copy of show program per horse and Judge's cards.

**STABLING:** Stall Fee is \$50.00 Assignment of stalls is entirely at the prerogative of Show Management. One horse per stall. Exhibitors are prohibited from moving stalls without the permission of the Show Management. Every stall reservation must be accompanied by an entry and every horse stabled at the show must be entered in at least one (1) class. No stall reservations will be held after closing date of entries unless payment in full has been received. **Stabling is available at \$22 extra per day per stall for those who would like to arrive earlier than Friday July 3, 2009. Please call Amanda Hunter at (506)433-4594 to arrange for early arrival.**

**TACK STALLS:** Tack stalls are \$45.00 per stall for a box stall. If an exhibitor uses a vacant straight stall they will be charged \$25.00. If you use a stall you did not reserve, you will be charged for it. **You will be CHARGED FOR A TACK STALL IF YOU USE ANY EXTRA SPACE FOR DISPLAYS.** Tack stalls will not have any bedding.

**TBA Class** To Be Announced Classes can be purchased by an exhibitor for \$25.00 per class. Once the class has been purchased, other exhibitors can enter the class for the performance class fee of \$12.00. Please fill out the class you wish to purchase and specify the TBA slot where you would like the class to go on your entry forms. TBA classes are on a first come first serve basis, which will be determined by the post date on an exhibitor's entry form envelope.

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Please refer to the current Equine Canada Rule Books, Sections A (*General Regulations*) and B (*Breeds*), for complete descriptions of classes at these horse shows. The Rule Book is available on-line from the EC website: [www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca). **Please note:** for AHA medal class requirements please refer to article 1117.6 in the AHA handbook. The AHA handbook is available online from the AHA website: [www.arabianhorses.org](http://www.arabianhorses.org). The Show Steward will be available on the show grounds to answer any questions regarding class descriptions.

#### AHA SADDLE SEAT MEDAL CLASS

1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used.

#### AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL CLASS

- 1) All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res. 25-06)
- 2) Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- 3) Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- 4) In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
- 5) The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5. (Res.25-06)
- 6) **Numbers must be worn on the rider's back or in the case of reining seat equitation on the left side of the saddle pad and must be clearly visible at all times when in competition. See USEF rule EQ103.6. (Res. 8/07)**

#### AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS

- 1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

## **AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS**

1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR222. (BOD 5/06)

### **Article A503 Local & Miscellaneous/Additional classes**

The following classes at these shows are not rated for Equine Canada awards, and are not recognized by AHA: 36, 39, 68, 70, 76 (one day only), 78..

**LEADLINE:** (Class 36) Exhibitors must be 2 to 6 years old, and may not enter any other class at this show. Stallions not allowed. Exempt from AHA membership. May be asked to trot/jog.

**OPEN PARTNERS (ENGLISH/WESTERN):** (Class 39) First rider to enter and work the horses the first way of the ring. Horses to line up and second rider to mount and work horse the second way of the ring. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope. To be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation, with emphasis on consistency of performance with both riders.

**FREESTYLE LIBERTY:** (Class 70) Limited to 8 entries, 2yrs and over. Limit of 1 horse with 1 or 2 handlers in the ring at one time; performance not to exceed 2 minutes. At the end of performance, horse must be caught within 1 minute or be disqualified. To be shown without tack at any gait, at the direction of the handler(s). Judged on animation and overall beauty. No attachments allowed on whips.

**FRANK GREYDANUS MEMORIAL OPEN PLEASURE CHALLENGE:** (Class 76 Saturday only) This is a Performance class open to all Pleasure horses. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. Entry fee - \$12.00 and will be pinned 6 placings.

**MARITIME BRED:** (Class 78) This is a Performance class open only to horses that have been bred in the Maritimes. Both the sire and dam must be standing in the Maritimes and Maritime owned. Maritime Bred Certificates must accompany entry form. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. Horses are to be stripped and judged 60% conformation and best of type: 40% performance. Entry fee - \$12.00 and will be pinned 6 placings.

**FREESTYLE REINING:** (Class 68) Will be a minimum of 3 ½ minutes. Requires four consecutive spins in each direction, minimum of one lead change at lope from right to left and one from left to right, and a minimum of three stops. Additional maneuvers are appropriate and will be given credit.

**DRESSAGE TESTS:** (class 88, 89, 90, 91 Sat only) These dressage tests are strictly for fun and no points will be awarded. Each test is \$12.00 per exhibitor. An exhibitor can have a caller and hunter attire is acceptable. All other rules apply as stated in the Equine Canada Dressage Rule book. ## **BARN AND SHOW GROUND RULES**

**PLEASE OBSERVE AND RESPECT THE FOLLOWING RULES AS IT IS FOR YOUR SAFETY AS WELL AS THE SAFETY OF YOUR HORSES AND OTHERS.**

*The ACAHA hopes common courtesy will be the order of each day; if you notice something or someone that could result in a potential hazard please advise the show office immediately.*

- **NO SMOKING** is allowed in the barns or the show ring area.
- **NO HEATING APPLIANCES** (e.g. toasters, coffee makers, BBQs etc) **may not be used within any barn** (with the exception of hair dryers/blowers used in animal grooming).
- All Fireproof material must be used for all stall decoration.
- **All exits and aisles will be kept free from obstruction.** Vehicles must not block accesses or fire lanes.
- Please keep aisles swept at least twice a day.
- All fire extinguishers, fire pulls and fire alarm stations shall be free and clear of obstructions and be readily visible in their designated locations.
- Any hardware used in stalls must be removed prior to leaving.
- Stalls must be cleaned at least once per day and put in appropriate containers provided outside (**no garbage**).
- Place Garbage in appropriate places.
- Please place returnable containers in appropriate recycling containers.
- Graffiti will not be permitted in barns or stalls. You will be billed for any type of damage.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash and attended to.
- **CHILDREN ARE NOT TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED.**
- No motorized vehicles of any type including scooters, golf carts or mopeds are allowed in the barns, practice areas or any normal routes used by horses.
- **Exhibitors are free to bring their own bedding from home if they wish - provided it is either shavings or sawdust. Straw, peat moss or other forms of bedding will not be permitted.**

**Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be caused to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the show grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her, and shall indemnify the Management against all legally established claims or damages of any kind.**
